DIRECTIONS TO Purina Farms

From St. Louis or Springfield, MO

Take I-44 to the Gray Summit exit (Highway 100). Go north and follow Hwy 100 until you spot Hwy MM and the Purina Farms sign (approximately 1/2 mile). Turn left onto Hwy. MM. Drive about one mile until you reach the Purina Farms Visitor's Center on your left. Turn left into Purina and pass thru the security checkpoint. Follow the signs to the field.

From Kansas City

Take I-70 east to the Warrenton exit at Hwy. 47. Go south on Hwy. 47 for approximately 25 miles until you reach Hwy. 100 in Washington. Turn left onto Hwy. 100 and continue to I-44 (approximately 10 miles). Go east on I-44. Follow the directions above from Springfield.

MASCUSA Agility Trials November 6 – 7, 2023

Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, email the trial secretary at secretary@livetrial.net (preferred) or phone (815) 242-5483. Except for the first class of the day in each ring, all start times are approximate. Dogs in the “B” / Master classes will run first, followed by dogs in the “A” / Excellent classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the “A” / Excellent classes in their corresponding jump height. FAST classes will run with a single walkthrough, and in these classes dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the Regular program in each jump height.

CONFLICTS: During the morning briefing on Monday anyone with conflicts for scent work will be given a tag for their leashes. We cannot hold an agility ring but will adjust run orders. Agility has priority over scentwork.

WALKTHROUGHS: We will be splitting walkthroughs in FAST, T2B and Master/Excellent Standard and Jumpers. Please note we will be doing this as **Walk/Walk/Run** so you will need to be available to walk the course at the beginning of the class.
