

In order to avoid having to show a height card at the trial, send a copy of your height card or yellow-sheet from an official measuring along with your trial entry. If a copy is not received, exhibitors of dogs jumping other than 24 inches in the Regular program and exhibitors of any dog in the Preferred program must present the official card at check-in or the dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in any class. If an AKC representative or VMO is scheduled to be present at this trial, all dogs not having an AKC height card must be measured prior to competing.
