The club will be offering a CGC test on Saturday, November 30th at 4:00 p.m. or 30 minutes after judging has finished in the Jumpers ring. Spots are limited to 20 dogs. Registrations will be taken on Saturday beginning at noon.

MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the trial secretary only. Forms may be mailed to Robert Olson, 22W462 Sycamore Dr., Glen Ellyn, IL 60137 or emailed to secretary@livetrial.net. No phone move-ups.

Pretrial moveups (for any trial day) must be received by the trial secretary by 6:00 p.m. Monday, November 25, 2013. Day to day moveups are offered, and must be completed by the time the last ribbon is awarded on Saturday.

Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs the same class. *A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.*

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, may result in the exhibitor being brought before a Trial Committee. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts between rings should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

WAIT LIST: The club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries per day will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing at 6:00 pm, November 12, 2013. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on Monday, November 25, 2013 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on November 25, 2013 will not be charged. **If you wish to be placed on the Wait List, please mark the top of the entry form.**

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following exception: full refunds for bitches in season and partial refunds (\$5 per run will be retained by the club) injured dogs pulled after the final withdraw date will be allowed. Request for refund must be made in writing, before judging begins, and accompanied by notice from a veterinarian.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dog and handler teams earning their MACH or PACH title will receive a special title rosette and a decorated jump bar. Dogs earning a PAX title will receive a special title rosette. New title ribbons will also be available for any dog completing a title. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. No ribbons or prizes will be mailed.

CATALOGS: Catalogs will be available by presale. If you would like a catalog, check the catalog box on your entry form and include \$10.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the trial for \$10.00 each.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program. Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. Instead, please fill out the section at the top of the entry form. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

SAFETY: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/OBSTACLES: Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through may be split at the judges discretion. The judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. **There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs at any of these trials.**

ELECTRONIC TIMERS: This trial will be using electronic timers in all rings.

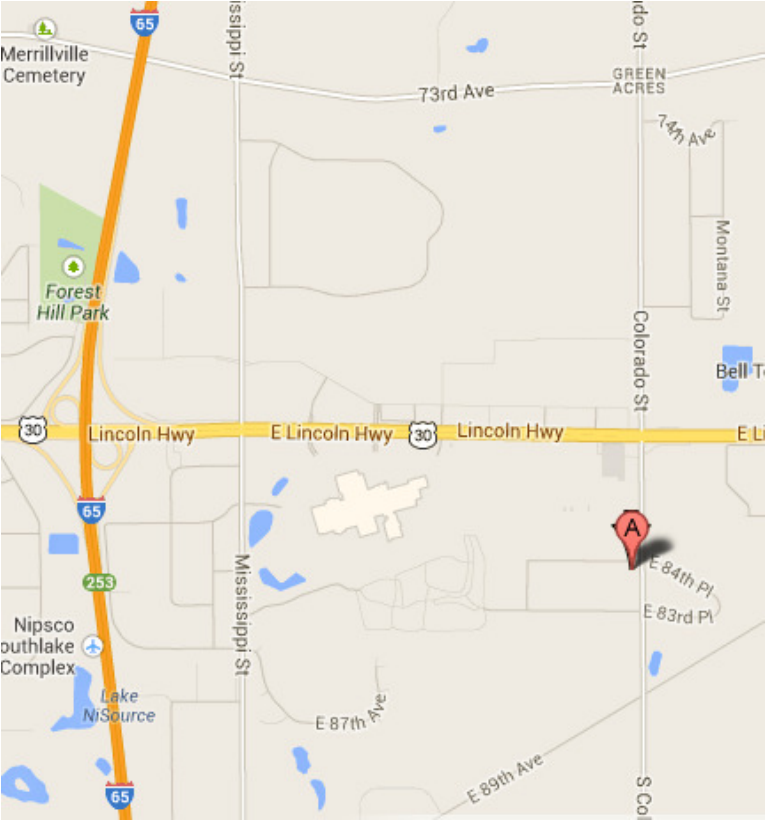

SITE INFORMATION: The agility trial will be held at the Hallmark Sports Club, 8328 Colorado Street, Merrillville, IN 46410. This trial will be held indoors on soccer turf. Indoor crating is allowed, crate mats or other ground cover must be used underneath all crates. Food is available on site, and there are fast food restaurants nearby. Dogs must be walked in the designated exercise areas. Anyone found exercising their dogs across the street from the complex will be asked to leave with no monies refunded!

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
