## AKC Agility Trial

September 27 – 28, 2008



### WELCOME!

Welcome to the September Stone City agility trial!  
We hope you all have a great time.

All weekend, the building opens at **7:00 a.m.** and judging commences at **8:30 a.m.**

Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, email the trial secretary at [rdotrialsec@sbcglobal.net](mailto:rdotrialsec@sbcglobal.net) (preferred) or phone (630) 790-8426. Except for the first class of the day in each ring, all start times are approximate. Dogs in the “B” classes will run first, followed by dogs in the “A” classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the “A” classes in their corresponding jump height. Walk-throughs will be split at the discretion of the judges.

**ARMBANDS:** If you submitted a height card, your armband will be available at the front desk as you enter the building, along with course maps and running orders for the day. If you did not submit a height card or your temporary height card has expired, you will need to come to the scoretable to show your height card and receive your armbands. If you do not have a height card, your dog will need to be measured before you are allowed to run if you are not jumping in the highest height class. In the event a VMO is present you will need to be measured if you do not have a height card, no matter your height class.

**WORKERS:** We could still use some volunteer workers. If you would like to help with this trial please contact Melissa Bortles at [jeffmissy1@comcast.net](mailto:jeffmissy1@comcast.net). No experience necessary. Volunteers who work at least 4 hours will receive a compensatory lunch.

**CRATING:** Lots of indoor crating space is available. Mats must be used under crates.

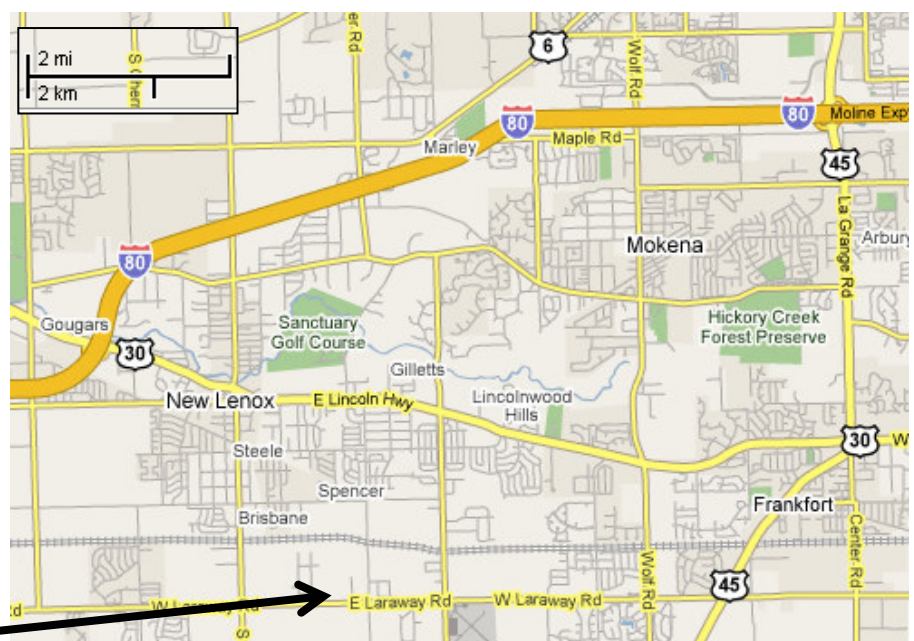
**FOOD:** Food will be available for purchase on-site.

### SITE INFORMATION:

Stone City Kennel Club is located approximately 4 miles west of Rt. 45, or 1 mile east of Cedar Road on Laraway Road in New Lenox.

**FROM I-80 (eastbound)** take Rt. 30 exit south. Go 1.5 miles and turn right onto Cedar Road. Go 2 miles and at 4-way stop sign turn left (east) onto Laraway and go 1 mile. Clubhouse is located on the North side of the road.

**FROM I-80 (westbound)** take Rt 45 exit south. Go 5.6 miles and turn right onto Laraway Road and go approximately 4 miles west. Clubhouse will be on your right.



Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be dismissed from the trial with no monies refunded.

Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the "A" classes in their corresponding jump height.
