WELCOME

Welcome to Collie Club of America National Specialty Agility Trial! We hope everyone has a great time. Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, email the trial secretary at secretary@livetrial.net (preferred) or phone (630) 790-8426 (After March 18, use phone number (630) 456-0097). Dogs in the Master or B classes will run first, followed by dogs in the Excellent or A classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the Regular classes in each jump height.

LOCATION: We are in the Covered Arena directly East of the main show site, past Freedom Hall and the North Wing. See map on page 3.

SETUP: No site access is available on Monday. Building opens 7 a.m. EDT Tuesday morning. We will be unloading the equipment and setting courses first thing Tuesday morning so please come by to help if you are available.

WORKERS: Since this is a small trial, we'll need all the help we can get. If you would like to volunteer there is a signup form available at <http://rdolson.org/premiums/#cca-agility>. If you can stay around after the show on Wednesday to help load the equipment that would be greatly appreciated! Workers will get fed!

ARMBANDS:

If you did not note on your entry form that your dog needs to be measured, your armband will be available for pickup, along with course maps for the day. If you do not have a height card, your dog will need to be measured by a Volunteer Measuring Official. We have two VMOs this trial – Jim and Judy Smotrel – so if you have a dog who is over two years of age and hasn't been measured you can have both your required measurements taken care of.

FOOD: Concessions will be available at the main show site in the West Wing.

DIRECTIONS:

Louisville International Airport, The Kentucky Exposition Center (Fairgrounds), and the Crowne Plaza host hotel (Phillips Lane) are all located at the intersection of I-65 and I-264 (Henry Watterson Expressway). Side entrances to the Kentucky Exposition Center are off both Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway (KY 61).

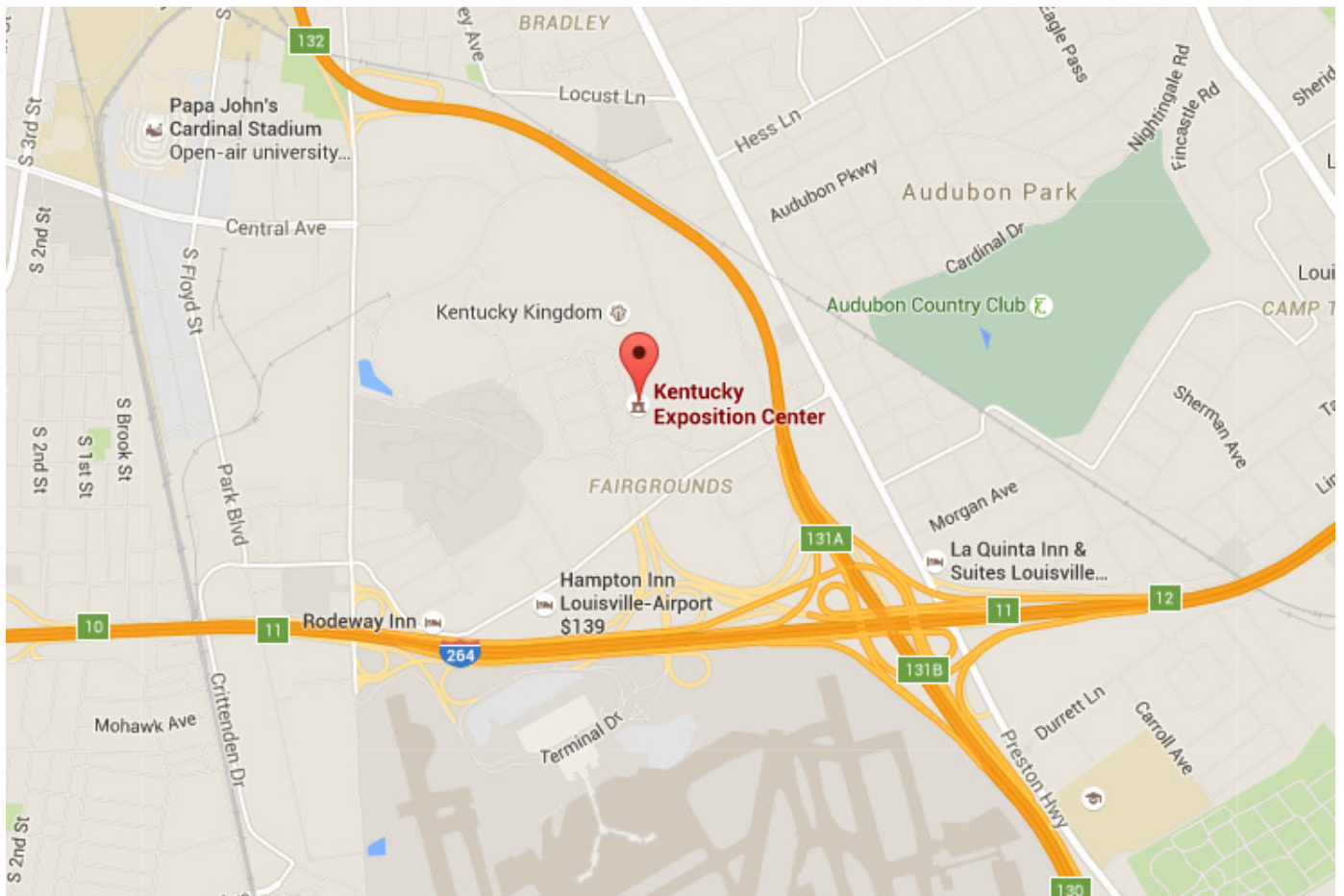
From the North--take I-65 south

From the East--take I-64 or I-71 west

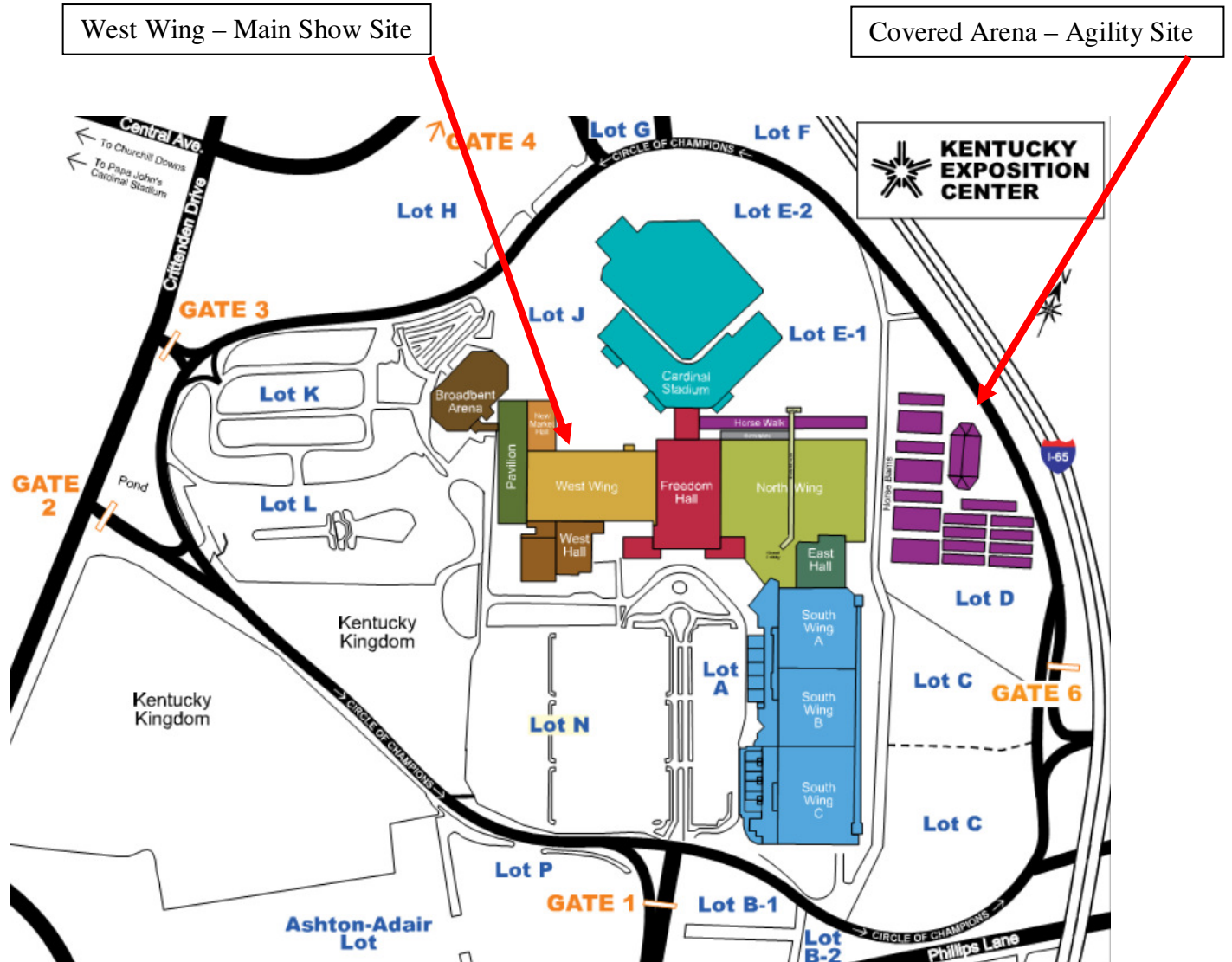
From the South--take I-65 north
