

Welcome to Collie Club of America National Specialty Agility Trial!

The building opens at 8:00 a.m. on Monday and 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday. Judging starts at 10:00 a.m. on Monday and 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday.

Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, please email the trial secretary at secretary@livetrial.net (preferred) or phone (815) 242-5483. Except for the first class of the day, all start times are approximate. Dogs in the “B” or “Master” classes will run first, followed by dogs in the “A” or “Excellent” classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the “A” classes in their corresponding jump height.

CATALOGS: Each exhibitor will receive a performance events catalog (one per exhibitor across all three performance events). You’ll be able to pick these up at each of the performance events.

HELPING OUT: In order for the trial to move smoothly we will need to have everybody pitch in to help. If you want to help but don’t know what to do let us know and we can help you learn something new!

MEASUREMENT: If you need to be measured, judge David Nauer is a VMO.

CRATING: There is limited crating in the Event Center. There is additional crating in adjacent rooms.

FOOD: Light lunch food will be available on site for purchase (cash only so be prepared). Food and drink will be provided for workers.

ONLINE INFORMATION: We will be using Agility Gate for gate steward sheets and checkin. I’ll be sending the access code in your final confirmations. We will also have online score posting available at <https://livetrial.net/cca>

MOVEUPS: As a reminder the moveup deadline for pre-trial moveups is Monday, March 23, 2026. Day to day moveups must be given to me at the show site before I leave for the day.

SITE INFORMATION: As always, clean up after your dog, even out in the fields. Do not let your dog urinate on the building or on the outside garbage cans. Remember that hotels are considered by the AKC to be part of the trial site, so exhibitors observed not picking up or causing disturbances at the hotels may face AKC sanctions. We’d like to be able to keep using these hotels for dog shows, so please continue to be exemplary dog owners.




DIRECTIONS TO AGILITY SHOW SITE:

From the main show site: Take 21st St East to S. Yale St. Turn right and drive 1 mile. Turn left on E 31st St and use the right lane to merge onto OK-51 East / US-64 East. Drive 8.8 miles. Take the exit toward Lynn Ln. Use the right two lanes to turn right onto S 177th Ave / N 9th St / S Lynne Lane Road. Drive 1.5 miles. Turn left on to E Memphis St. The show site will be on the left.
