We will be in the area that was used for obedience and rally in the SageNet Center.

CATALOGS: Each exhibitor will receive a performance events catalog (one per exhibitor across all three performance events). You'll be able to pick these up at each of the performance events. Running orders will be posted at the show and on my website <https://rdolson.org/CCA> after the close of the waiting list.

WAITING LIST: We have a waiting list for both trials. If you cannot make it to the trial let me know by 6:00 p.m. CDT on Tuesday, March 31, 2026 and we will refund your entry fee and let someone into the trial from the waiting list. If you are on the waiting list and do not want to remain there, please let me know. Keep an eye on your email as that is how I will notify you if you make it into the trial.

MOVEUPS: We are accepting moveups for these trials. They must be submitted 30 minutes before the start of the trial. If you know head of time you need a moveup, please send it to me as soon as possible. If you finish a title during the first trial, congratulations! Come to the secretary's table and you can submit a moveup for the second trial.

CRATING: Crating is available in the Obedience & Rally space in SageNet Center.

FOOD: Concessions are available at the show site.

SITE INFORMATION: As always, clean up after your dog. Do not let your dog urinate on the building or on the outside garbage cans. Remember that hotels are considered by the AKC to be part of the trial site, so exhibitors observed not picking up or causing disturbances at the hotels may face AKC sanctions. We'd like to be able to keep using these hotels for dog shows, so please continue to be exemplary dog owners.

It is against AKC rules to access the trial site prior to the trial for practicing.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

The address of Expo Square is 4145 East 21st Street, Tulsa, OK 74114.

From Oklahoma City (I-44, eastbound Turner Turnpike)

- From I-44, exit at Yale Avenue
- North (left) on Yale Avenue to 21st Street
- Turn west (left) on 21st or 15th Street

From Joplin (I-44, westbound Will Rogers Turnpike)

- From I-44, exit at Yale Avenue
- North (right) on Yale Avenue to 21st Street
- Turn west (left) on 21st or 15th Street

From Muskogee (Highway 51, westbound Muskogee Turnpike)

- Exit Highway 51 at Yale Avenue
- At exit ramp, turn west (left) on 31st Street
- At first light, turn north (right) on Yale Avenue
- Turn west (left) on 21st or 15th Street

From Stillwater (Highway 51, eastbound)

- Highway 51 turns into Highway 412, and then Highway 244
- Exit Highway 244 at Yale Avenue
- At exit ramp, turn south (right) on Yale Avenue
- Turn west (right) on 21st or 15th Street

From Highway 244, eastbound

- Exit at Yale Avenue
- At exit ramp, turn south (right) on Yale Avenue
