MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the trial secretary only. Move-ups for Saturday, December 31st must be received not later than noon on Monday, December 26th. Move-ups for Sunday, January 1st will be accepted on Saturday, December 31st until the last ribbon has been awarded. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs the same class. *Move-ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B after the closing date this trial.*

ENTRY INFORMATION: Entry fee is \$23 for the first entry, per dog, per day and \$12 for the second entry of the same dog, per day (includes \$3 AKC recording fee). Mail all entries with fees (checks or money orders only) **payable to GLBTC** to: Robert Olson, 22W462 Sycamore Drive, Glen Ellyn, IL 60137-7406.

A maximum of ten (10) dogs may be submitted per envelope of entries

Entries that are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Express mail entries must waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. All illegible or incomplete forms may be returned. Trial secretary assumes no responsibility for incorrect entry information due to illegibility of the entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on entry forms with the AKC agreement printed on the reverse side. Entries submitted without the agreement will be returned.

If any exhibitor wishes to know that they made it into the trial after the draw, he must include a self-addressed stamped postcard or envelope to be returned after the draw date. No other method of notification of acceptance will be made! Exhibitors will be contacted by the trial secretary only if they are placed on an alternate list or do not make the draw.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This sanctioned trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee. Partial refunds after the closing date will be allowed for bitches in season or injured dogs upon presentation of a written request for refund, accompanied by a veterinarian certificate, to the trial secretary no later than 1/2 hour prior to the start of judging.

SAFETY: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes and prizes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons and a dog treat will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Teams earning a MACH title will be awarded a jump bar and rosette. No ribbons or prizes will be mailed.

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Great Lakes Belgian Tervuren Club, and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

RINGSIDE: The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run. Conflicts between the rings should be discussed with the gate steward prior to the start of the class.

CATALOGS: Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors for no charge. Catalogs will be available by presale. If you would like a catalog, check the catalog box on your entry form and include \$6.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the trial.

MEASURING: All dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary jump height card issued by the AKC must be measured by a judge of record prior to competing. If you have not previously submitted a copy of your AKC height card to this trial secretary, please include a copy with your entry. If a copy is not received, exhibitors of dogs jumping other than 24 inches in the Regular program and exhibitors of any dog in the Preferred program must present the official card at check-in or the dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in any class. If an AKC representative or VMO is scheduled to be present at this trial, all dogs not having an AKC height card must be measured prior to competing.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

8"	4"	For dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
12"	8"	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers

20"	16"	For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers

In Preferred classes a dog MUST jump 4 inches lower than regular height.

In REGULAR classes handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in regular classes but not in a division lower than their proper height division. **Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated**

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/OBSTACLES: Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through may be split at the judges discretion. The judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs at any of these trials.

SITE INFORMATION: The agility trial will be held at the Soccerville Vetta Sportsclub, located at 8328 Colorado in Merrillville, Indiana.

The complex is approximately 1.8 miles east of I-65 and just off US 30. From I-65, exit at US 30 and go east. Go past Southlake Mall and turn right onto Colorado – look for the Sports Authority sign on the southeast corner of US 30 and Colorado. The complex is less than ½ mile down Colorado, on the right (west) side of the street.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be dismissed from the trial with no monies refunded. Indoor crating is allowed; crate mats or other ground cover must be used underneath all crates. Dogs must be walked in the designated exercise areas. Anyone found exercising their dogs cross the street from the complex will be asked to leave with no monies refunded.

Food may be available on site. There are also many nearby restaurants available.
