## Havanese Club of America National Specialty AKC Agility Trial August 6, 2013



Thank you for entering the Havanese Club of America National Specialty agility trial. This trial is being held at Pawsitively Heaven Pet Resort, 10051 Kitty Avenue, Chicago Ridge, IL, 60415. Breakfast, coffee, and water will be provided. Fast food is also available nearby. Crating is allowed inside the building, but no flexi-leads.

Parking in the lot is limited. Orange cones are strictly for loading/unloading. You may park anywhere in any space in the Pawsitively Heaven lot that does not have an orange cone. Parking staff will be there to help exhibitors unload and watch over equipment. No RVs or motor homes allowed.

In addition to non-coned spaces in the Pawsitively Heaven lot, exhibitors and guests are welcome to park in the Chicago Ridge Firehouse lot off of Virginia Ave. Also the Chicago Ridge public works parking lot will be available off of Virginia Ave. Street parking is not recommended due to the truck traffic in the weekday mornings. We do not have permission to use the large paved lot across the street of Kitty.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS! Potty areas will be clearly marked. Anyone caught not picking up after their dog(s) will be asked to leave without a refund.

Building opens at 6:00 a.m. The inside temperature will be around 66 degrees so bring appropriate clothing.

Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, please email the trial secretary at secretary@livetrial.net (preferred) or phone (630) 790-8426. Dogs in the Master or B classes will run first, followed by dogs in the Excellent or A classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the Excellent or A classes in their corresponding jump height.

If you did not request measurement on your entry form, your armband will be available for pickup, along with course maps for the day. If you did request measurement, you will need to have your dog measured by judge Sue Fregien, who is an AKC Volunteer Measuring Official, and then come to the score table to pick up your armband. If you run and are not measured the AKC will remove any legs you may have earned at the trial. If you have received a valid temporary or permanent height card since sending in your entry (i.e. your confirmation still shows "measure"), please let me know so I may mark the database properly and have your armband available in the self-check-in area.

## Directions to the site are as follows:

From the north: Take I-294 South to 95th Street (also Rts 12/20) and exit east. Stay to the right and take the ramp to Harlem Road south (second ramp, first will put you back onto I-294 north). At the first light turn left onto 99th Street. Go to the stop sign and turn right onto Sayre Avenue. Turn left at the next stop sign onto Virginia Avenue. Turn right at the next stop sign and continue on Virginia Avenue. Pawsitively Heaven will be on the left side of the street, just past the fire station.

From the south: Take I-294 North to 95th Street (also Rts. 12/20) and exit east. Stay in the right lane and take the ramp to Harlem Road south. At the first light turn left onto 99th Street. Go to the stop sign and turn right onto Sayre Avenue. Turn left at the next stop sign onto Virginia Avenue. Turn right at the next stop sign and continue on Virginia Avenue. Pawsitively Heaven will be on the left side of the street, just past the fire station.
