Move Ups between trials WILL be offered. Move ups must be received by the Trial Secretary 30 minutes before the start of the second trial. See the trial secretary for a moveup form.

Pre-trial move ups are accepted. They must be received by the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial. If submitting a moveup on the day of the trial, a paper submission must be submitted. Email moveups to secretary@livetrial.net are accepted prior to the day of the trial.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Collies SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

ENTRY FEES

*an entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class. Entry fees include a \$3.50 per run AKC recording fee.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Robert Olson at secretary@livetrial.net. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the

Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

Collie Club of America is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing at 6:00 pm, March 13, 2024. Any entries that are withdrawn by 6:00 pm on Tuesday, April 2, 2024 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on April 2, 2024 will not be charged. If you do not wish to be placed on the Wait List, please mark the top of the entry form.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A **warm-up area:** the club shall designate a warm-up area. One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class. **Search Area Conditions.** Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

Search Area Sizes will be as required in the *Regulations for AKC Scent Work*

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area. The club will attempt to allow spectators at this show; we are limiting the spectators for any one run to five. Check during the general briefing to learn which classes will allow spectators.

Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide.

Crating space will be available in the Rally/Obedience area.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

A **New Title rosette** may be awarded to dogs finishing a title.
All placements will receive a collapsible water bowl.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Collie Club of America and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Collie Club of America reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Collie Club of America or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following exception: bitches that come in season or dogs suffering an injury may have their entry fee returned, less an \$8.00 per day administrative fee, by sending a signed statement from a veterinarian, on their letterhead, to the Trial Secretary by at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your armband number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

To Peoria Civic Center - Marquee Lot

From the East - Interstate 74 west to exit 93 (Adams St / Jefferson Ave). Turn left onto NE Jefferson Street (2nd traffic light). After passing through the intersection with Fulton Street, continue on Jefferson but move into the "right turn only" lane. This lane will take you into the Civic Center driveway and Marquee Parking Lot.

From the Northeast - Interstate 80 to Interstate 55 South to Interstate 74 west. Then follow the "from the east" directions.

From the North - I-39 south exit 14 (US-24 west). Turn left at the bottom of the exit to head west on US-24. US-24 joins US-150 west after approximately 27 miles. Continue over the bridge. Take the next exit for IL-29 south/Adams Street. Turn right onto IL-29/Adams. Adams Street becomes Jefferson Street when the street splits into 2 one-way streets. After passing through the intersection with Fulton Street, continue on Jefferson but move into the "right turn only" lane. This lane will take you into the Civic Center driveway and Marquee Parking Lot.

From the South - Interstate 155 North to Interstate 74 west. Then follow the "from the east" directions.


From the West - Interstate 74 east to exit 92B (Glen Oak Ave / Downtown Peoria). Move to the right lane after exiting. Bear right onto NE Glendale Ave (traffic light is there). Glendale will turn into William Kumpf Blvd. Turn left onto SW Monroe Street. Turn right at the first intersection onto Fulton Street. Turn right onto Jefferson Ave and move immediately into the "right turn only" lane. This lane will take you into the Civic Center driveway and Marquee Parking Lot.

To Peoria Civic Center - Fulton Lot –

From the West - Interstate 74 east to exit 92B (Glen Oak Ave / Downtown Peoria). Move to the right lane after exiting. Bear right onto NE Glendale Ave (traffic light is there). Glendale will turn into William Kumpf Blvd. From Kumpf turn left onto SW Monroe St. Turn left at the first intersection (Fulton St) into the Fulton Parking Lot.

From the East - Interstate 74 west to exit 93 (Adams St / Jefferson Ave). Turn left onto Monroe. At Fulton St (1 block after Main St) turn right into Fulton Parking Lot.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
