Returned checks will incur a \$25 fee. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone not cleaning up after his or her dog will be requested to leave the trial.

The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

CRATING AND SETUP: Crating and setup times will be announced in the judging program.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following exception: bitches that come in season may have their entry fee returned, less an \$8.00 per day administrative fee, by sending a signed statement from a veterinarian, on their letterhead, to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 a.m. the day of the Trial.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Dogs must qualify to receive awards. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Placement rosettes will be rewarded for 1st through 4th place in each class in each height division. New title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing an agility title at this trial. All prizes must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed. Additional special prizes will be available and are described in the center pages of this premium.

Dogs receiving a MACH or PAX will receive a rosette and award bar. Please contact Ericka Wojack at ewojack@comcast.net if you think you may complete one of these titles at this trial.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Directions to **Marina Animal Clinic:** Leave Expo Square, turn left(east) on 21st go approximately 3 miles, Clinic is on the right at corner of E 21st & 191st E Ave, just past 144.

Directions to **Animal Emergency Center:** Leave Expo Square, turn left (east on 21st Go south on Yale 2 miles to E. 41st then left on 41st 1 1/2 miles. Clinic on the right in Commerce Square.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: All collies fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) are eligible to participate, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

SAFETY: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/OBSTACLES: Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through may be split at the judges discretion. The judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. **There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs at any of these trials.**

MOST VERSATILE COLLIE AT THE 2011 NATIONAL SPECIALTY

Most Versatile Collie Trophies Tapestry Throw 50 x 60; Rosette; 15" CCA Silver plated Loving Cup offered by Collie Club of America

Most Versatile Collie Qualifiers Qualifying Rosette

To be eligible for this award a Collie must participate in at least three of the four AKC events offered by the CCA (Breed, Obedience/Rally, Agility or Herding). Sign up for the award at any performance event. You must sign up for the award to be eligible, and signup sheets must be turned in to Jim Smotrel by the end of the agility trial.

The following rules will be used to determine the winner from the Collies that qualify for the award. Note that weighting factors are used in each of the performance events to recognize the increased difficulty of the higher level classes. MVC points awarded in the conformation classes have been updated. In the non-BOV classes, points are awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in the class. All scores will be recorded from the posted Judge's sheets. Jim Smotrel will maintain the official scores at this show.

RULES FOR THE MOST VERSATILE COLLIE AWARD

To be eligible for this award, your Collie needs a qualifying score in at least three of the four AKC events at the National Specialty. Only one score will be counted for each event. The Collie obtaining the highest point total will win the award. In each event, the highest score that can be obtained towards this award is 100. The following scoring system will apply:

HERDING: (For Exhibition Only classes do not count)

Herding Tested Class:	Passing: 50 points
Pre-Trial Tested Class:	Passing: 50 points
Started Trial Class:	90% of total score (out of 100)
Intermediate Trial Class:	95% of total score (out of 100)
Advanced Trial Class:	100% of total score (out of 100)

OBEDIENCE/RALLY OBEDIENCE:

Since this is an individual award, Brace Class Performances do not count.

RULES FOR THE MOST VERSATILE COLLIE AWARD (continued)

BREED:

- All Collies that are a conformation Champion or have at least 5 championship points will receive a minimum of 40 MVC points for entering and showing in a conformation class at the CCA National.
- Collies with less than 5 championship points will not automatically receive any MVC points for showing in a conformation class. Points will only be awarded for placing in a class and defeating competition.
- Since this is an individual award, Brace Class performances do not count. No points will be awarded to Collies entering a conformation class and not showing (i.e. marked absent).
- In the BOV class, points will be awarded as follows:
 - Making no cuts: 40 points
 - Making first cut: 50 points
 - Making second cut: 60 points
 - Making third cut: 70 points
 - Awards of Merit: 80 points
 - Reserve Winners: 75 points
 - Winners: 80 points
 - Best of Winners: 85 points
 - BOS to BOV: 90 points
 - Best of Variety: 100 points
- In all other conformation classes, points will be awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in that class as follows:
 - No placement 40 points for conformation Champions and Collies with 5 or more CH points
0 points for Collies with less than 5 CH points
 - Placements Two (2) MVC points are awarded for every dog defeated in the class up to a maximum total number of 70 MVC points.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
