AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box on the entry form)



The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

* Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

** A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

**Don't forget to check the box on your entry form as to your AKC NOHS eligibility.
It must be done at the time of entry.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: Express mail entries must waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. All illegible or incomplete forms may be returned. Show secretary assumes no responsibility for incorrect entry information due to illegibility of the entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on entry forms with the AKC agreement printed on the reverse side or they will be returned.

Catalogs may be pre-ordered by checking the selection on your entry form and including an additional \$4 with your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase on the day of the show for \$5 each.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

COVID/RSV/FLU Precautions: By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19/RSV/FLU. Masks are optional but recommended as cases are increasing. The club will abide by all Local, State, and Federal Regulations regarding COVID-19/RSV/FLU, which are subject to change prior to the show and may involve mandatory mask wearing.

Only entered dogs are permitted on the grounds. Any dog causing a disturbance must be removed from the ring area. All dogs must be on leash at all times. Please stack crates when possible. Exercise pens will be allowed at the show chairman's discretion.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

NO SMOKING allowed in the building

Dogs are not required to be at the show until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when required for judging.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors must comply with the Illinois Department of Agriculture Rule.

SITE INFORMATION: This show will be held at the Stone City Kennel Club, 13606 W. Laraway Road, New Lenox, IL 60451. Lunch will be available to purchase.

Directions to the site are as follows:

Stone City Kennel Club is located approximately 4 miles west of Rt. 45, or 1 mile east of Cedar Road on Laraway Road in New Lenox.

FROM I-80 (eastbound) take Rt. 30 exit south. Go 1.5 miles and turn right onto Cedar Road. Go 2 miles and at 4-way stop sign turn left (east) onto Laraway and go 1 mile.

Stone City building is located on the North side of the road.

FROM I-80 (westbound) take Rt 45 exit south. Go 5.6 miles and turn right onto Laraway Road and go approximately 4 miles west. Stone City building will be on your right.



Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884 —the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs. These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years. Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect,
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
