**DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE:**

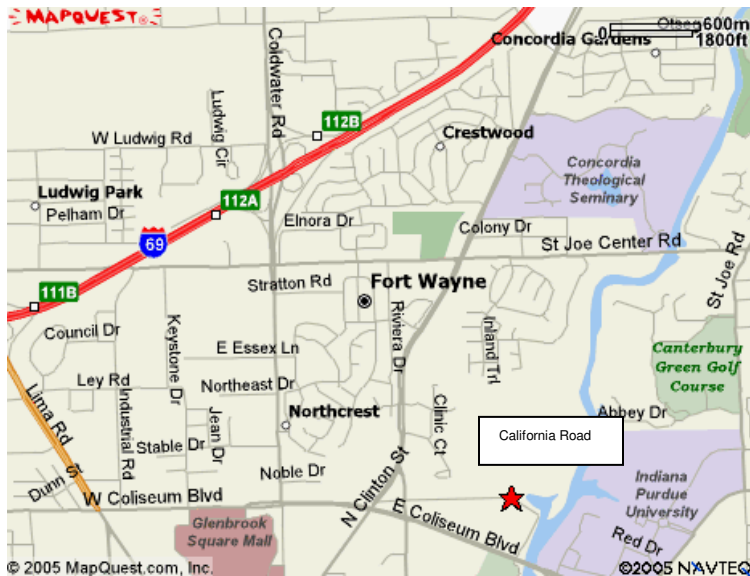
Most folks coming in from out of town will probably do best to come in from Exit 112 on Interstate 69. For our friends from the East, take I-469 North around town to I-69 (you will enter at Exit 115), then go South on I-69. Please note: California Road is a small, L-shaped road connecting with both Parnell and Coliseum; it is not clearly marked.

**From I-69.** Take I-69 to exit 112 (Coldwater Road South and IPFW). -Take Coldwater Road South to the first light at Washington Center Road. -Turn Left onto Washington Center Road and take that to the 3<sup>rd</sup> light to Clinton. -Turn Right onto Clinton for a mile and a half.

-After the second light at Outback Steakhouse and Pizzeria Uno, get in the Left lane. -You will turn Left at the next light, which is Parnell. (Turning right would take you into the Kohl's parking lot.) -Take Parnell 300 or 400 meters (yards) to California Road, just before the power station. Do not cross Coliseum Blvd. Turn Left onto California Road. Take California Road .4 mile. There is a sign with "Hefner Soccer Fields - IPFW - The Plex" at the bridge over the creek. Turn Left over the bridge and go straight. -The Plex is the large building on the Right side of the road.

**From West US 30.** Take the Coliseum Exit from US 30 and take Coliseum Blvd. (930) all the way past Glenbrook Square mall on the right side. After the mall, the next three intersections are Coldwater, Clinton, and Parnell. Get into the Left lane before Parnell. At the intersection of Parnell and Coliseum, there's Memorial Coliseum on the Right, a Shell gas station on one corner and Public Safety building (look for the police cars) on another, with the American Red Cross behind Public Safety. Turn Left onto Parnell then IMMEDIATELY turn Right, just past Public Safety and the power station, on California Road. There is a small sign advertising the Plex. - Take California Road about .4 mile. There is a sign with "Hefner Soccer Fields - IPFW - The Plex" at the bridge over the creek. Turn Left over the bridge and go straight. -The Plex is the large building on the Right side of the road.

**From East US 30.** From the East side of IPFW, take Coliseum Blvd. (930) past the main campus of IPFW on your right. After crossing the St Joe River bridge go to the next light, Paul Shaffer Drive, turn right (this is at the new Holiday Inn across from the Memorial Coliseum) go to the stop sign and turn right onto California Rd. Go about .2 mile. There is a sign with "Hefner Soccer Fields - IPFW - The Plex" at the bridge over the creek. Turn Left over the bridge and go straight. -The Plex is the large building on the Right side of the road.

**Dogs Eligible to Enter This Trial:** All dogs fifteen months of age that have an AKC Registration Number or Purebred Alternative Listing Program/Indefinite Listing Privilege Number (PAL/ILP) number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds; except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

**Course Familiarization and Warm-up:** Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. **There will be NO obstacle familiarization for Novice at this trial.**

**Obstacles:** Agility obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles as described in the current AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

**Jump Heights:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper jump height divisions. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Championship classes but not in a division lower than their proper height. A dog may not jump at a higher height in the Preferred classes. If the dog's height at the withers exceeds the maximum allowed for the jump height which the dog has entered, the dog shall be moved up into the proper jump height if the dog was measured prior to their run. In no case may a dog be moved down in height based on a judge's measurement at a trial.

**Height Cards:** All dogs competing in AKC Agility should have an official AKC Jump Height Card. Please send a photocopy of your dog's height card with his entry to these trials. If you do not send a copy of your dog's official Height Card, you will have to present the card prior to the start of the class or have the dog measured by the Judge. Any dog that has not been officially measured for a Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by the Judge of Record prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial weekend only. If an official Jump Height Card is not presented or the dog is not measured by the Judge of Record, the dog will not be eligible to compete.

**Classes Offered:** Novice A & B Standard, Open Standard, Excellent A & B Standard, Novice A & B Jumpers With Weaves, Open Jumpers With Weaves, Excellent A & B Jumpers With Weaves. Novice Preferred, Open Preferred, Excellent A & B Preferred, Novice Jumpers Preferred, Open Jumpers Preferred, and Excellent A & B Jumpers Preferred. No dog may participate in more than one Standard and one Jumpers With Weaves class per day.

Owners may choose to enter the Preferred Standard Agility Class and Preferred Jumpers With Weaves Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard Agility Class and the Regular Jumpers With Weaves Class at any trial. The dog must be entered only in Preferred Classes or in Regular Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials.

**Please see the official AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for the complete descriptions of the classes offered at these trials.**

**Collars & Leashes:** At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle or rolled leather collars but there shall be no attachments hanging or otherwise allowed on the collar. Dog's names and/or identifying information may appear on the collar. No title, awards, or advertising may appear on the collar. Pinch/prong and electrical collars (dummy or not), head halters and special training collars are not allowed anywhere on the trial grounds. A leash may not have excess material dangling from the leash, nor may it have any attachments including a fleece or leather wrap.

**Food and Toys:** Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or device.

**CATALOGS:** Will be available

**Ribbons and Prizes:** Rosettes will be given for all placements, and a toy will be awarded to the first thru fourth place dogs in each jump height and each class. A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. A rosette will be given to those finishing an agility title or earning a double Q in the Exc. B classes. Dogs finishing a MACH or PAX will also receive a bar & rosette. All ribbons, rosettes, and prizes must be claimed at the trial - none will be mailed. Dogs must qualify to receive placement awards.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

The safety of the dog is of primary concern. Exhibitors acknowledge that, by entering these trials, that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and of the AKC, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to safely perform all obstacles.

**AVMA Health Statement:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. Each exhibitor is responsible for being at ringside when it is his/her turn to run.

All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or at the designated warm-up area.

An entry without correct fees or with post-dated checks does not constitute a valid entry and will be returned. **All entry forms must include the official AKC Agreement and Rules on the reverse side to be considered valid.** No refund will be made for duplicate entries. Effort will be made to find duplicates but if the entry is processed, no refund will be made. Exhibitors are responsible for errors on the entry form, regardless of who makes said errors. No entry fee will be returned in event of such errors nor will there be cancellation of entries, after the published closing date. No entry will be made nor accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Express delivery entries must be allowed to be left at secretary's address without recipient signature. No telephone or fax entries will be accepted. **MAXIMUM of 10 entries (dogs) per envelope.** Entries received before the opening day will be returned. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds. The Fort Wayne Obedience Training Club assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Owners or handlers entering dogs in this trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the AKC and the Regulations for Agility Trials. FWOTC may decline any entries or may remove any dog from its event for due cause. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. Unsportsmanlike conduct including rough handling or misconduct of any kind will result in excusal from the ring or trial area.

**Refunds.** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees (minus \$8 per dog per day) will be refunded for bitches in season or for injured dogs if a veterinarian certification (on appropriate letterhead) is received by the trial chair or trial secretary by 3:00PM on Sunday, October 18, 2009.

**ALL HANDLERS MUST PICK UP AFTER THEIR DOGS!** Anyone not picking up after his dog at the show site or the motel will be requested to leave with NO refund.
