WAIT LIST: Illiana Collie Fanciers is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the May 30th closing date. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and time of May 30th, 7:00 p.m. Any entries withdrawn by Monday, June 11th at 6:00 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list and into the trial by June 11th will receive a full refund.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: No more than 10 entries allowed per envelope. No online entries will be accepted. Express mail entries must waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for **complete**, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Trial secretary assumes no responsibility for incorrect entry information due to illegibility of the entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Final entry confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 18 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing a working email address will be emailed their confirmations, all other exhibitors will be sent their confirmations via the US Postal Service.

Full refunds for bitches in season and partial refunds (\$5 per run will be retained by the club) injured dogs pulled after the final withdraw date will be allowed. Request for refund must be made in writing, before judging begins, and accompanied by notice from a veterinarian. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts between rings should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs and yourselves.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

CATALOGS: Catalogs will be available by pre-sale. If you would like a catalog, circle "Catalog" on your entry form and include \$10.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available the weekend of the trial. Running orders will be available to all exhibitors upon request and posted around the show site.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dog and handler teams earning their MACH or PACH title will receive a special title rosette and a decorated jump bar. Dogs earning a PAX title will receive a special title rosette. New title ribbons will also be available for any dog completing a title. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. No ribbons or prizes will be mailed.

CLASSES: All Standard and Jumpers with Weaves. There will be no ISC, FAST, T2B or non-regular classes at this trial. Electronic timers will be used at this event.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION: Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class following the judges briefing. The walk-through may be split at the judges discretion.

MEASURING: Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in as long as they properly fill out the new AKC entry form. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.


