PLEASE NOTE - COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

We will be instituting the following rules as we wish to present as small a risk as possible to all involved, and to ensure the best possibility of holding these shows.

These rules are subject to change depending on State, Local, and National regulations, and Venue & Club directives at the time of shows. Any of the following COVID-19 Protocols may be relaxed, eliminated or strengthened based on the current conditions at the time of the show.

Final details will be provided in the judging program.

Please read the following carefully.

- All exhibitors & attendees will be required to show proof of vaccination or proof of negative COVID-19 test taken within 48 hours of the day of the shows. **NO proof – NO admittance!**
 - Masks will be required to be worn inside the show building at all times unless actively eating or drinking. Please bring your own masks! A limited supply will be available for purchase at the show at a cost of \$5.00 each
- To maximize the space available and allow for social distancing:
- Exhibitors will be limited to 3 crates in the building. You may stack additional crates as long as there are only 3 crates on the floor. Additional dogs entered can be crated in your vehicle and rotated inside as needed.
 - No ex-pens will be allowed indoors!
 - Plastic must be used under grooming areas. Please bring your own plastic or tarp.
 - Exhibitors will be required to set their crates & tables up following the marked areas on the floor. Please be respectful of your neighbors' space when setting up yours!
 - Spectator seating **WILL** be limited **OR** may be unavailable. (See judging program)
- If spectator seating is allowed,
- **NO personal chairs** will be allowed, and **NO saving of seats.**
 - **NO food or drink will be allowed ringside** – **NO** exceptions! All food and drink must be consumed in your grooming area or outdoors.
 - **NO** air-force dryers, hair dryers, or fans will be allowed. Only battery-operated individual crate fans will be allowed. No electricity will be available!

Plastic must be used under grooming areas.
Exhibitors must bring their own plastic or tarp.

Setup of equipment will be permitted Friday Feb 25th from 6-8pm. The building will be available at 7:00am Saturday and Sunday. No dogs are allowed in the building overnight. No overnight parking is allowed.

ALL videotaping and photography during the show requires Club permission.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice. This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class.

Master. This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC Event Records Department at 212-696-8281. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship is entered on the front and back of entry form.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

If the show is cancelled due to COVID all entry fees, catalog orders, and lunch orders will be refunded in full.

Only entered dogs are permitted on the grounds. Any dog causing a disturbance must be removed from the ring area. All dogs must be on leash at all times. Please stack crates when possible. Exercise pens will be allowed at the show chairman's discretion.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

NO SMOKING allowed in the building

Dogs are not required to be at the show until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when required for judging.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors must comply with the Illinois Department of Agriculture Rule.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

SITE INFORMATION: This show will be held at the Francis 4-H Field facility at 801 E. Francis Road, New Lenox, IL 60451. Lunches will be available by preorder only. There are fast food restaurants nearby.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

INSTRUCTIONS
1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard)

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
