An exercise area will be provided. All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone not cleaning up after his or her dog will be requested to leave without a refund..

The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run. Conflicts between the rings should be discussed with the gate steward prior to the start of the class.

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following two exceptions: injured dogs or bitches that come in season may have their entry fee returned, less the \$10.00 per day administrative fee, by sending a signed statement from a veterinarian, on their letterhead, to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 a.m. the day of the Trial.

**PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Rosettes & stuffed toys (value \$1.50) will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. A MACH bar and rosette will be awarded for teams earning their MACH, at either of our trials --- so PLEASE let us know, in advance, if you are entered and there is a chance of your team earning a MACH by informing our Trial Chairman. New Title rosettes will also be available to those finishing a title at the show. All awards must be claimed the day of the Trial --- none will be mailed or shipped.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Illinois law requires proof of rabies vaccination. Additionally, exhibitors are required by Will County and Illinois State health requirements to maintain proof of either rabies vaccination or titer.

**MEASURING:** All dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary jump height card issued by the AKC must be measured by a judge of record prior to competing. *Due a change in AKC regulations, I am no longer allowed to keep height cards on file. If you wish to avoid showing your card at the show please include a copy with your entry, preferably not using an entire sheet of paper to do so. If a copy is not received, exhibitors of dogs jumping other than 24 inches in the Regular program and exhibitors of any dog in the Preferred program must present the official card at check-in or the dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in any class. If an AKC representative or VMO is scheduled to be present at this trial, all dogs not showing an AKC height card must be measured prior to competing.* 

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

**SAFETY:** The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**CATALOGS**: Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors for no charge. Catalogs will be available by presale. If you would like a catalog, check the catalog box on your entry form and include \$10.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the trial.

**COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/OBSTACLES:** Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class.
