Dogs Eligible to Enter

- This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The TRIAL SITE will be available to exhibitors from 7:30 am to 30 minutes after the trials are completed each day.
- Building and rest rooms are handicapped-accessible. Free parking.
- NO food is available at the trial site.
- CRATING in designated areas only. There is NO SPACE for unentered dogs. See CoVID-19 rules for details on crating.
- Exhibitors are responsible for clean-up of their dogs. Please deposit waste in provided containers.
- No smoking permitted in building.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.

Masks must be worn 100% of the time while in the building. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

NO ONE other than the person showing a dog will be allowed in the building. **No guests or spectators**.

Judging times will be noted in the program. We will not start before the listed time. Please do not arrive more than 60 minutes before your class. When your class is over, please leave the building. If you want to socialize, please do so outside.

We will have a central steward who will check you in for your class. Armbands will be spread out on a table (no stacking) for you to pick up. Please practice social distancing while waiting in line.

Crating will be allowed on the agility side of our building. We will rely on you to practice social distancing while setting up your crate(s) and chair. Crates and chairs MUST be 6' apart. Rows will be marked to insure a 6' aisle. There will be **NO CRATING OR CHAIRS** allowed on the ring side of the building. **Depending on the number of entries, crates may have to be brought in daily**

You will be allowed to watch at the rings but only in designated areas. **STANDING ROOM only with social distancing. No dogs in the spectator area.**

We will have two rings with an attached practice ring at each. The steward will call the next dog to the practice ring to warm up his dog. There will be **NO** warm up anywhere but the practice rings.

All surfaces will be wiped down after each entry. Stewards will wear gloves and change after each entry. All equipment will be handled by gloved stewards. We will not have table stewards unless specifically requested by the judge.

Only you will touch your leash and/or dumbbell.

Inanimate objects will be used as figure 8 posts.

We will have a separate entrance and exit within the building.

We will also have a separate entrance and exit at each ring.

Please do not touch anyone else's dog or equipment.

We ask everyone to follow the guidelines set by the Federal, State and AKC committees to allow us to be safe while enjoying our sport. There is a separate waiver within the premium that you must sign and send with your entry.
