ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR OTHERWISE RESTRICTED EXCEPT WHEN WORKING STOCK. Under NO circumstance will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding Regulations). American Kennel Club Rules regarding Conduct will be strictly enforced.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

PLEASE FILL OUT ENTRY FORM LEGIBLY AND COMPLETELY.
There will be no refunds for duplicate entries or errors on entry forms.

Alternates List: Runs limited to 50. Entries received after the numerical limits have been reached but prior to closing will be placed on an alternates list. If you DO NOT wish to be on the alternates list, please enclose a signed statement to that effect with your entry. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered.

Per Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Herding Regulations, "In tests and for move-ups from a test class to a trial class, alternate entries shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved-up. Within the trial classes, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries.

Alternates will be permitted to run if there is an absentee in an earlier class (provided the alternate's class has not begun) which was not filled on the same course, same type of livestock and under the same Judge, or if a dog has been marked absent with the Event Secretary prior to the beginning of the alternate's class."

Entry fees will be refunded for alternates whose dogs do not run.

Bitches in season will be placed at the end of the running order in test classes and run in catalog order in trial classes. Please notify Trial Secretary if your bitch is in season.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Illiana Collie Fanciers, Inc. and site owners assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or spectators, or by any of their dogs or property.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in the maker's entries being accepted on a CASH ONLY basis.

Errors on Entry Forms: Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in case of any such errors after the closing date.

ENTRIES CLOSE Friday, October 9, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. CDT. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as is practical.

Declination of entries: The Committee may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have recourse against the ICF, any official thereof, or any judge.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian, Judge, or Tester, or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the organizing committee, it is impossible to open or complete the test/trial, no refund of entry will be made. Extreme weather conditions, including, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme temperatures, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, livestock, exhibitors, judges and spectators. The well-being of dogs, livestock, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the test/trial before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

COVID-19 Precautions, Requirements, & Event Plan

As states continue to open and revise recommendations, Illiana Collie Fanciers will be complying with the Illinois Governor's, and Kane County's current guidelines for gatherings. Additionally, Illiana Collie Fanciers will be following the AKC and CDC recommended best practices for this trial. Illiana Collie Fanciers is committed to providing a safe environment for the exhibitors, volunteers/workers, and judges. Below are the precautions and requirements which Illiana Collie Fanciers will be implementing.

Refunds: If the trial cannot be held, an email notification will be sent out to all exhibitors. Full refunds will be given, and entry checks will be shredded if the trial is cancelled prior to closing. If the trial is cancelled after closing, refunds (full or partial) will be given. The amount of the refund will be determined by the club based on the offset any expenses incurred for planning and attempting to hold the trial.

Spectators: To help us stay within Illinois & Kane County's guidelines for the number of attendees at an event, spectators will not be allowed. These events are limited to Exhibitors only.

Parking: As you park at the trial site, please leave sufficient space between vehicles to allow for effective social distancing.

Masks: Masks will be required in all common areas. Volunteers, including stock handlers, are also required to wear masks. Exhibitors will not be required to wear a mask during their run. Masks should be worn until exhibitor is inside the course fence (e.g. same area where leash would be removed). Exhibitors are expected to supply their own masks.

Additional Expectation of All Exhibitors, Judges, & Volunteers:

- Social distancing must be practiced. Maintain a distance of 6 feet or more unless individuals are part of a family unit.
- Hand sanitizer will be available to exhibitors at the trial site.
- No handshakes or hugging (unless individuals are part of a family unit).
- Do not touch dogs that are not your own.
- Do not share electronic devices except within a family unit.

Restrooms: There will be portable restrooms on the show site with hand washing capabilities. Please follow the CDC guidelines on washing your hands.

Food: Food and/or drinks will not be available for exhibitors or volunteers. Please plan accordingly.

Briefings: Briefings will be held at the discretion of the club and judge. Masks and social distancing are required during all briefings.

Judging: The judge will be assigned a scribe. The judge and scribe will maintain social distancing. Timing will be done by either the judge or the scribe. The scribe and judge will bring their own pen/pencil. No common use pencils, pens, or markers will be available.

Stock Handlers: All stock handlers will be required to wear a mask in circumstances where social distancing (6 feet from other people) cannot be maintained. As much as possible, social distancing should be practiced.

Secretary Area: The trial secretary's designated space will be considered "sacred ground". Barriers, marker paint, or similar will be used to define a six-foot perimeter to protect the trial secretary. Anyone who violates the space of the trial secretary will be asked to leave the trial grounds and may not return for the duration of the trials. No refunds for entries will be provided in this instance.

Posting of Results, Ribbons, & Awards: A gate board will be available in a designated location for exhibitors to view the running order, course maps, and scores. **DO NOT TOUCH THE BOARD.** Scribe sheets, ribbons, and awards will be set out on a table for exhibitors to pick up at the conclusion of each class. No scribe sheets, ribbons, or awards will be mailed. Results will be sent via email to the email address provided with the entry at the conclusion of the trial. Title ribbons, if earned at the event, may be requested from the trial chair. Title ribbons will be left for the requestor in a designated place.

The COVID-19 Event Plan for exhibitors and workers has been provided with the premium. Any changes to the COVID-19 Event Plan, due to updates in the Illinois Governor's, or Kane County's guidelines and/or CDC recommendations, will be outlined in the judging program.

A signed Waiver of Liability (included in this Premium) for COVID-19 must be completed for each exhibitor and submitted along with your entry. Entries received without a signed waiver will not be accepted.

Additionally, **EVERY** person entering the Trial (show?) grounds will be required **DAILY** to fill out a COVID-19 Information/Disclosure form.
